4	Development Trust update	Open meeting last week updated on Forest paths , wind turbines, community broadband, Glendaruel Hub and Cowal Way. Wind turbines won't be affected by withdrawal of subsidy. Planning will be submitted at end of June. Hydro scheme has fallen through due to insufficient generation capacity. Feasibility study to be done on best options for Glendaruel Hub.	
5	Councillor's report	<p>News today has come through that the cuts won't be quite as bad as previously intimated. 22 million over 2 years instead of 26 m</p> <p>Integrated Health & Social Care - should be well established by end of 2016. Strategic Plan has been published and will be shared on CC website. Self-directed Care private providers have been linked to certain areas rather than piecemeal. It may be advisable to train some local people to deliver care, or back-up care.</p> <p>Argyll & Bute are losing three councillors because of falling population. All loses are anticipated to be in Cowal area.
