5	Police Update (PC Grant)	<p>4 incidents - 1 wildlife, badger caught in a trap - wildlife officer dealing with that. Rest are cows on road, road traffic (speeding). Low value thefts have been reported. Expecting more incidents during the summer period. SNP signs were removed during election</p> <p>Theft of a bin was reported. Rubbish on Colintrave shore road. Bottles are being thrown about. Strachur CC have made contact about wild camping and agreement has been made to keep note of inappropriate incidents for monitoring purposes.</p>	<p>PC Grant will visit the site over the weekend. Will report to Inspector Wilson.</p>
6	Development Trust Update	<p>Cowal Way is still the main project. Infrastructure work will be at more north end - Lochgoilhead area. Stronafian Forest. CGDT has been approached about running more training courses. Funds will be made available. Six week course for 4-6 people. It is hoped a qualification/ticket will be gained. Trainers will be brought in. This should result in employment possibilities thereafter. Proposal to look at childcare provision in Glendaruel Village Hall for under fives two afternoons a week. New trustees - Cathleen Russell has agreed to join the Trust as a coopted member and will stand with election at AGM. A discussion has been had about developing a website that will have links to all other community organisations.</p>

7	Kyles Community Broadband Update	The project is currently reviewing and scoring the tendering documents received from interested parties. Preferred bidder should be identified by end of month. Then a couple of months until contract would be awarded. Until then, it will not be known when broadband will be rolled out in the community.	
8	Councillor's Report (Gordon Blair)	<p>A rota has been drawn up on 6 monthly basis for councillors to attend CC meetings. Bins - small bin lorry now operating on West Glen road.</p> <p>Area Committee meeting this morning. Jim Anderson will take on the Integrated Joint Board. Paul Farrell happy to come along to look at popular wild camping site and advise/help with signage.</p> <p>The cutting of verges and overhanging trees was raised. Lorries having to go into centre of road to avoid branches, forcing oncoming into verges. Cllr Blair explained that there is a system to record issues and apparently CCs can access - no information has been received about this.</p> <p>The state of the Colintraive shore road was raised. A cone has had to be put over a 'sink' hole.</p> <p>Local Development Plan should be due out this year.</p>	<p>J McLuckie will advise on likely sites.</p> <p>GB will find out when LDP will be issued.</p>
9	Health & Social Care update (C Grant)	<p>IJB - Kieran Green only councillor who has remained on, but now there is a councillor from each area. Robin Creelman is now chair for next two years.</p> <p>New Care Home model being rolled out. Problem in rural areas for recruiting and retaining staff.</p> <p>'virtual care' is a proposal for people to be cared for at home as if they were in hospital - input from Consultants and specialists included.</p> <p>Struan Lodge to be retained as the beds are needed due to other closures. A redesign plan is needed to develop services to meet needs of adults and older people. A group has been set up to work on this and will report to IJB in March 2018.</p>
