9	Health & Social Care update (C Grant)	There have been recent Locality Planning, Communication and Engagement and Struan Lodge Redesign group meetings. Contact has been made with McGill's buses re the possibility of buses from McInroy's point being routed via Inverclyde hospital to ease the problems faced by the public when either visiting or attending hospital. Work has started on pharmacy reviews to try and alleviate the overspend and ensure medication safety on prescribed medication. Between April and September 19 carers assessments were completed by Crossroads support worker. A way is being looked into how these can be recorded and shared appropriately. Trust housing, Manse Gardens, Strachur will now be Amenity housing, there has been day assessment input and no additional needs have been identified at this time however social work will continue to monitor. 1,000 Voices are now involved in re-organising social activities within the complex. There has been a decrease in sleepovers for learning disability clients due to increase in technical support.
