Funding will run out at the end of 2018 to pay for employees (e.g. marketing and ranger).</p> <p>Crowdfunding campaign to be launched to complete the work – require approx. £50K.</p> <p>Official launch of the name change, taking place at Scottish Parliament on 18th of December 2018.</p>	
7	Kyles Community Broadband Update	<p>KCB withdrawing as a community effort. Couldn't guarantee 100% coverage for all, and therefore wasn't compliant enough for local needs.
