		<p>John Dreghorn leading group looking at need for both Care Home placement and housing provision for ageing population. Struan Lodge redevelopment group has now disbanded.</p> <p>Midwifery provision is currently in year 2 of 5 year plan. Very good response from survey. Midwives double up and where possible same midwife will see mum-to-be at each visit and on delivery. Trial use of maternity support worker, which is a short course. Support worker would be used to assist with families with greater support needs. Increase in use of virtual appointments. 14 week programme for newly diagnosed dementia patients. Very little cost = £186 per programme needs to be funded centrally.</p>	
12	Planning	<p>Stronafian Lodge – request to plant a forest with mixture of trees.</p> <p>A new application for a house in Stronafian has been put in. Noted that it would be advantageous for a passing place to be put in with all new housing applications in areas such as Stronafian, to aid the increased foot-and car-fall.</p>	
13	AOCB	<p>23rd November 2018 – Bonfire will take place at 5pm to burn remains of the Beacon of Light Ceremony. Feedback from Beacon of Light event was all very positive. A great evening, pleased to see so many local children participating. Dunoon Community Council received a certificate for participating.</p> <p>Signage for Rural Watch and Litter – postponed until spoken to Bob Baines to see if Bute Estate will contribute to cost of signage for the areas proposed. Cathleen Russell brought up litter issues at recent CAUCUS meeting with the Police Inspector who suggested writing to the National Park to get advice from them, partly because they have stopped Wild Campers which look now for other locations.
