5	Police Update	<p>From the last 3 months there have been 26 incidents – mostly road traffic and speeding incidents.</p> <p>A&amp;B Council have agreed traffic calming measures will be installed in Colintraive this financial year. No official timeframe.</p> <p>The fraudsters who caused some distress in the ColGlen area were caught by the police. Proposals have been put forward to close the Tighnabraich and Lochgoilhead Police Stations. The front counter at Dunoon Police Station is also to be closed over night. There is a proposal for the use of mobile stations instead. Proposal for the houses and offices in these areas to be closed and sold, and money used to resurrect the mobile station initiative.</p>
