Health & Social Care update	There was a meeting on Friday, Joanna MacDonald invited A&B Council officials and Dunoon Community Council – shown round hospital and Struan lodge – discussing a grand plan to rebuild or refurbish everything and have a new integrated social care and hospital. All sounded great, but not sure where money will come from. Very similar to what the Struan lodge development group suggested. They are going to be looking at it. If the council sells something then the council keeps the money, but if the healthboard sells something it goes into the national pot. Certainly the council has property scattered all over Dunoon, it would be better to have them all together along with an integrated social care, be great if it all came off.
