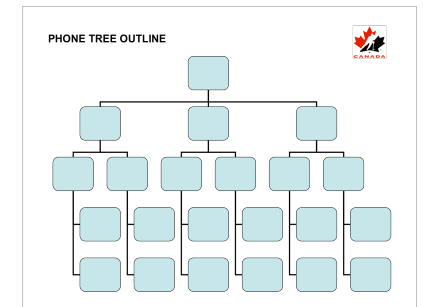
Dear Community Member

We live in a world where we are all very independent but at the same time, we depend on one another, especially in an emergency.

ColGlen Resilience Group are gathering information to help keep our community better informed and more resilient.

To do this we need to know who, how and what people can do to help.

One of the things we are keen to establish is a telephone tree where in an emergency you would be contacted by a named person. 3 main coordinators would have all the contact details, and they will contact 3 specific people on their list who will in turn contact 3 specific people, and so on. People will only be issued with the contact details of the 3 people that they are responsible for contacting and the person responsible for contacting them.



If anyone cannot be contacted the coordinators would be informed immediately. Using this method, we can contact a lot of people very quickly depending on the emergency.
