CC's asked questions about why the Shore Road had not yet been resurfaced although the council had assured us it would have been done prior to the last Argyll Rally. MWR informed meeting that even the Argyll Rally organisers were shocked by the state of the road which is also a school bus route. WS was asked to find out when the road is to be resurfaced. 2. Road resurfacing down past Dunans has been completed but the resurfacing stopped short of the worst part where there are lots of potholes. WS was asked to find out why Hazard Warning Signs. DW asked WS why the undergrowth had not been cut back making them totally ineffective. 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Argyll Rally Report	Community Meeting 15th July Colintraive Hall. Consensus from the hall was positive. One fundraiser informed the meeting that they had raised over £1800 for the benefit of the school and Scottish Air Ambulance. ColGlen residents had engaged with the Dunoon CC questionnaire which covered the whole of the rally. ColGlen CC had specifically asked for feedback regarding community benefit re accommodation providers, businesses, etc. to be added to questionnaire and whilst we got some we would like to see more feedback information including a quantifying of local benefit. Suggestions - a collective local business advertising initiative next year, meet and greet competitors. This year the CC have engaged positively with the Rally and we have achieved partial success in getting some changes made and the CC will continue to try and get changes for future rallies implemented. Comments both positive and negative were received for the Shore Road and the West Road stages but no comment regarding the Bealachandrain stage. Meeting of Community Council Representatives. 18 August Glendaruel Hall and hosted by ColGlen CC. Round table discussion of rally and findings of survey organised by Dunoon CC. Initial proposals for next years rally were shared to allow CCs an opportunity to discuss and Advise changes. Proposals for this year for this area include: 2 sessions at Tarsan Dam section, 2 for Bealachandrain, 1 for the Shore road and 2 for the West Road. CC discussed and agreed with the objection to the Saturday morning closure of the Tarsan sections as it would greatly affect the ferry routes and impact on the various businesses including those in the tourism industry.
